A LEVEL This year our pupils have achieved a 100% pass rate, 75% of which was A*- C grades, and almost 30% of which is A*- A grades.

There were six students who achieved either A* or A grades in all their subjects. The college was delighted for the students who joined the Sixth Form from other schools. They settled very quickly into the day to day life of the college and achieved or exceeded their target grades.

GCSE Pupils taking the new Mathematics and English qualifications have done well with nearly 8 in 10 pupils achieving 4-9 grades in English and nearly 7 in 10 in Mathematics. The number of grade 9's (the highest grade possible under the new system) in English Language is double the national average.
